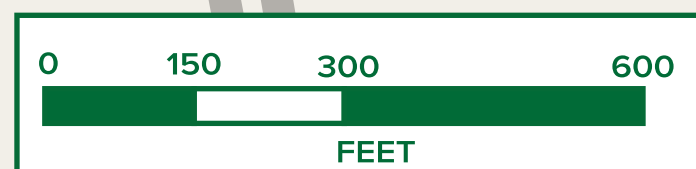

PARK USE GUIDE

- Park open sunrise to sunset.
- Trails are shared use. Dogs must be kept on a leash.
- Park unsupervised, use at your own risk.
- Motorized vehicles prohibited.
- Some trails include optional Technical Terrain Features (TTFs) for bikes only. Look for TTF and TTF bypass signs.
- Ride within your skill level.
- Helmets and protective gear recommended.

MOUNTAIN BIKE TRAIL RATINGS

- Black Diamond Trails**
 - very difficult
 - travel one direction ➤
 - optional terrain features
- Blue Square Trails**
 - more difficult
 - travel one direction ➤
 - optional terrain features
- Green Circle Trails**
 - easy
 - travel both directions ➤➤
 - features bridges

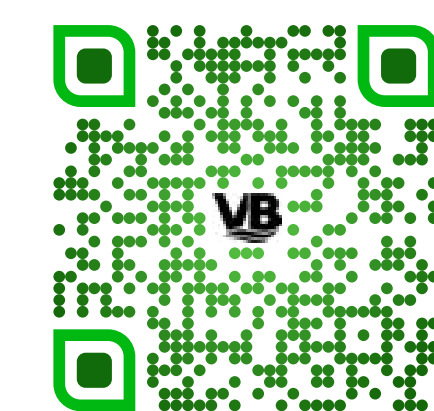

TRAIL GUIDE



- Marshview Connector - 0.4 mi**
Wide & mostly flat - travel either direction to access all trails except the Big Berm Connector.
- Big Berm Connector - 0.4 mi**
A narrow entrance trail with steep ascents and descents of hills and berms.
- Big Berm Loop - 0.9 mi**
Multiple berm climbs, jumps, hills, and optional Technical Terrain Features (TTF's).
- Oak Point Loop - 0.5 mi**
A wide and easy trail that brings you to a beautiful overlook of Owl Creek.
- Creekside Trail - 0.5 mi**
A narrow trail with tight turns that runs between the Oak Point Loop Trail and branches of Owl Creek. Optional TTF's.
- Little Berm Loop - 0.5 mi**
A challenging trail with rollers, steep berms, narrow passes through trees and optional TTF's.
- Heron Point Loop - 0.5 mi**
An up and down trail that follows Owl Creek under tree canopy and over roots.
- Old Road Trail - 0.5 mi**
A wide and flat trail through the Marshview forest under the canopy of large trees.
